

# WANTIRNA SOUTH PRIMARY SCHOOL

## Student Wellbeing Policy



### *Rationale*

To provide support for members of our school community who may require assistance due to varied life circumstances.

### *Aims*

To further develop and maintain community cohesiveness and connectedness the school community will:

- Maintain a fund committed to assisting at risk families within the school community.
- Abide by the administrative decisions made by the Wellbeing Officer and or school administration.
- Be proactive in communicating the intentions of the administrative body.
- Support students through varied life circumstances.

### *Implementation*

Consistent with these expectations, school policies shall be implemented according to the following guidelines:

- Wellbeing Officer and /or school administration (Principal Class) will oversee implementation.
- Policy will be reviewed when necessary (at least every three years) to ensure community need and expectations are relevant and articulated.

### *Procedure*

1. Create a support fund managed by school administration
2. Revenue to be generated through Parent's Association and community donation, the Parent's Association will support at the point of need.
3. Individual support to be determined by the Wellbeing Officer and/or school administration.
4. All relevant information will remain confidential.

5. Budget to be prepared and administrated by school administration and reported to school Council annually.

### *Other Policies*
